Meeting weekly, we play duplicate bridge and run a series of tournaments. We offer a welcoming and friendly atmosphere in which the bridge competition is enjoyable and rewarding for everyone, regardless of their level of experience. Suitable facilities are provided. We've got room for more players; new members are always welcome!

Our competitions for the next year starting on 1st April are:-

Summer pairs runs from 1st April for 6 months until 30th September. All duplicate pairs events to count where there are at least 3 full tables. The minimum number of games to be played is 6. The winning pair is the pair with the highest average % using their best 6 results to calculate the average.

Winter Pairs runs from 1st October for 6 months until 31st March. All duplicate pairs events to count where there are at least 3 full tables. The minimum number of games to be played is 6. The winning pair is the pair with the highest average % using their best 6 results to calculate the average.

Beaumont Cup is a duplicate pairs event taking place on a day in the middle of May.

Individual Fruit Bowl This is played as an Individual competition on a day in the Summer when we have any number of full tables.

Jubilee Cup iss played as a duplicate pairs competition, usually takes place on a day in Autumn.

Team events are run three times a year as a variant and fun to play. This, of course, requires full tables so these would be decided on suitable days. Pairs are joined up by lot to form teams.

Christmas Party, Military Movement. A fun game usually run on the last event before Christmas.

Mixed Pairs. Partners are drawn on the day and play duplicate bridge. The highest score wins. Usually run on a day in February. This event was formerly known as 'The Flitch'.
